JAMES ALEXANDER TILE

Ramsey will work on the waterway this week as weather allows. The old tile will be destroyed after the crops have been harvested.

ANTHONY HOOD OPEN

Lane Excavating has begun the maintenance project on this drain which involves removing trees and other debris.

SAMUEL KIRKPATRICK TILE

A small portion of the woods on the Noah property needs to be cleared to eliminate roots in the tile.

CARR/STANLEY TILE

The Surveyor still has not heard from the railroad but plans on following up on past phone calls. He plans on proceeding with locating the tile without getting on the railroad's right-of-way.
