STEWART HOLLOWAY TILE

The Surveyor received four complaints about water in the basements in Mays after the large rain that was recently experienced. Upon inspection, it was found the tile was totally blocked on the Disney property in Mays. This has been corrected. John Hall informed the Surveyor that the headwall for the main part of this tile has fallen. The Surveyor will see about repairing the outlet.
