

SPECIAL SESSION RUSH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEPTEMBER 12, 2016

The Rush County Commissioners met in Special Session on Friday, September 12, 2016, at 5:00 p.m. Those in attendance were Bruce Levi, Mark Bacon, Paul Wilkinson, Leigh Morning and Auditor Mary Ann Beard.

Commissioner Bruce Levi called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Mark Bacon made a motion to appoint Marvin Cole as a temporary alternate to the Board of Zoning Appeals. Commissioner Paul Wilkinson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

APC Executive director, Bryant Niehoff asked for the Commissioners input on Section 6.4 of the Rush County zoning ordinance. IC 36-7-4-607 further defines commercial WECS. It is the Commissioners obligation to initiate the amendment and then it will be sent to the APC. Attorney Leigh Morning verified that it will not impact any current litigation. Any action was tabled until the next regular meeting.

Commissioner Paul Wilkinson moved to place a moratorium on new negotiations with WECS developers or their representatives for a period of one (1) year from today's date of September 12, 2016. Bruce Levi seconded the motion. Paul Wilkinson voted yes. Mark Bacon voted no and Bruce Levi broke the tie with a "yes" vote. Motion carried.

The Commissioners then signed a plat vacation form that would consolidate the parcels of the jail property into one parcel. Mark Bacon moved to sign the form with Paul Wilkinson seconding the motion. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned on a motion by Commissioner Bacon and seconded by Commissioner Wilkinson.
