

The Rush County Drainage Board met in the Commissioner's Room of the Courthouse on December 22, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. with the following present: Mark Bacon, Paul Wilkinson, Bruce W. Levi, members; Leigh Morning, Board Attorney; Marvin L. Rees, Surveyor, Shelle Hendrix, Secretary.

A motion was made by Wilkinson with a 2nd by Levi to approve the minutes from the December 11, 2017 meeting. The minutes were approved and signed.

GEORGE SEELY NORTH TILE

The Surveyor recommended a reassessment of \$5. per acre and will require a hearing. Wilkinson made a motion to raise the assessment and hold a hearing on January 22nd, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. with a 2nd by Levi. Motion carried.

GEORGE SEELY SOUTH TILE

The Surveyor recommended a reassessment of \$3.50 per acre and will require a hearing. Wilkinson made a motion to raise the assessment and hold a hearing on January 22nd, 2018 at 10:30 a.m. with a 2nd by Levi. Motion carried.

L. F. McDANIEL TILE

The Surveyor reported this tile usually has maintenance work every year and has a negative balance. It was last assessed in 2015 at \$5. per acre. It was recommended to be reassessed at \$2. per acre and no hearing is required. A motion was made by Wilkinson to assess the Tile, with a 2nd by Levi. Motion carried.

JAMES ALEXANDER TILE

The Surveyor provided an update saying Ramsey will finish destroying the old tile and connect any laterals found, starting next week.

JAMES ANDERSON TILE

The Surveyor informed the Board that ADS has not gotten back with him as to their intentions of compensating for their tile splitting.

CARR/STANLEY TILE

The Surveyor reported the project continues to move forward and that Wesslers stated their coordinator with CSX is out of the office for the rest of the year and will offer an update in early January. The Surveyor plans to send a letter to all landowners of the properties on which survey work will take place.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Wilkinson with a 2nd by Levi. Motion carried.
