

DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING

SEPTEMBER 17, 2018

The Rush County Drainage Board met in the Commissioner’s Room of the Courthouse on September 17, 2018 at 10:15 a.m. with the following present: Mark Bacon, Paul Wilkinson, Bruce W. Levi, members; Leigh Morning, Board Attorney; Marvin L. Rees, Surveyor; Jonna McIntire-Johnson, Secretary. Dan Kinker, Todd McDaniel, and Mike McDaniel were also present.

A motion was made by Wilkinson to approve the minutes from the previous meeting with a 2nd by Levi. The minutes were approved and signed.

RUSH COUNTY STORM DRAINAGE POLICY

Desmond Stevens requested a waiver from a drainage permit on a house he is building in a subdivision at 700N and 700W. Leigh Morning confirmed that no motion was necessary. The written waiver was provided to the board and signed by Bacon, Wilkinson, and Levi.

Dan Kinker came before the board representing Todd and Mike McDaniel. He explained the details in regards to the drainage plan. Wilkinson made a motion to accept the drainage plan with a 2nd by Levi. Motion carried and the drainage plan was approved.

ASH TREES ALONG OPEN DRAINS

The Surveyor came before the board to discuss the ash trees along open drains. The board suggested that letters could be sent to all landowners but would be costly. Bacon suggested a newspaper/website article be sent to help inform all landowners. Levi suggested Rees contact Farm Bureau, Rush/Shelby Energy, Extension Office and Soil and Water. Additional information will be provided at the next Drainage Board meeting after speaking with the above mentioned parties.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Levi made a motion to adjourn with a 2nd by Wilkinson. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
