

**DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING**

**October 1, 2018**

The Rush County Drainage Board met in the Commissioner’s Room of the Courthouse on October 1<sup>st</sup> at 10:30 a.m. with the following present: Mark Bacon, Paul Wilkinson, Bruce W. Levi, members; Leigh Morning, Board Attorney; Marvin L. Rees, Surveyor; and Jonna McIntire-Johnson, Secretary.

A motion was made by Wilkinson to approve the minutes from the previous meeting with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Levi. The minutes were approved and signed.

**DAVID CANADY TILE**

Reconstruction of The David Canady Tile has been completed. The Rush County Highway Department will be paying for the reconstruction project. The Surveyor presented a schedule of assessments to the Board. Leigh Morning stated that a hearing needs to be set in 30 days for the schedule of assessments that are being modified.

The hearing is currently set for November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018 @ 10:30 a.m. Levi made a motion to proceed with the hearing and a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wilkinson.

**JAMES S E HILLIGOSS TILE**

The Surveyor came before the board to discuss the Hilligoss Tile reconstruction. The reconstruction hearing is set for December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018 @ 10:30 a.m. Wilkinson made a motion to proceed with the hearing and a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Levi.

**WILLIAM TINSLEY OPEN AND JAMES MEAL OPEN**

The Surveyor came before the board and presented his report on the Tinsley/Meal Open which can be found on file. He presented a schedule of assessments to the Board as well as suggesting the 2 drains be combined which will not require an actual hearing.

Due to the proposed schedule of assessments, a hearing has been set for December 10<sup>th</sup> @ 10:30 a.m. Levi made a motion to proceed with the hearing and a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wilkinson.

**BLOUNT/FLETCHER OPEN**

The Blount/Fletcher Open Drain is in need of maintenance. The Surveyor provided to the Board his recommendation for the repairs needed. He suggested that quotes be provided by local contractors to complete the maintenance project. A special meeting will be held on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2018 @ 8:30 a.m. to open the provided quotes.

**RUSH COUNTY STORM DRAINAGE POLICY**

Shane Houck is building a new home and shed in Ripley Township. The Surveyor provided the waiver to the board and was reviewed by Bacon, Wilkinson, and Levi. A motion was made by Wilkinson to approve the waiver with a 2<sup>nd</sup> from Levi. The waiver was approved and signed.

**JOHN ROSFELD POND ORDINANCE**

John Rosfeld requested a pond permit for his property in Rushville Township. The Surveyor stated the pond was built according to specifications. Mr. Rosfeld provided payment of \$250.00 made payable to the Rush County Treasurer’s Office for the pond permit on October 1, 2018. A motion was made by Wilkinson and a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Levi in favor of the permit.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Levi made a motion to adjourn with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wilkinson. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
