GLENWOOD DOLLAR GENERAL STORE

The Surveyor presented a blueprint showing a house that will be torn down in Glenwood near the Dollar General Store and discussed the retention pond. Wilkinson made a motion to approve the drainage plan with a 2nd by Bacon. Motion carried and the plan was approved and signed.

The Surveyor reported changes in INDOT’s policy regarding permits in that they must be certified and signed by an Engineer. He stated how they are on our Right-of-Way and that he will talk to Wesslers. Application for permits cannot be made until the Hearing was held. Wilkinson suggested contacting our State Senator since this causes more expense for the taxpayers. The Surveyor said he will do what he can to get certified.
