

DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING

JUN 10, 2019

The Rush County Drainage Board met in the Commissioner’s Room of the Courthouse on May 28, 2019 at 10:45 a.m. with the following present: Mark Bacon, Paul Wilkinson, Bruce W. Levi, members; Leigh Morning, Board Attorney, Marvin L. Rees, Surveyor; Shelle Hendrix, Secretary. Landowner Doug Hall was also present.

A motion was made by Wilkinson to approve the minutes from the previous meeting with a 2nd by Levi. Motion carried and the minutes were approved and signed.

TOWN OF GLENWOOD (H H ELLIOTT)

Several Glenwood residents appeared before the Board to seek solutions to drainage problems in the town of Glenwood, In. Denny Richardson spoke about the health dangers associated with the drainage issue. He stated the tile had been repaired several times by the town and now realize they cannot do that. Paul Wilkinson advised the residents to present a formal petition to the Surveyor in order to start the process.

CARR/STANLEY

The Surveyor confirmed with the Board there is a contract with Parr Richey to negotiate a reduction in Railroad fees.

JAMES S E HILLIGOSS

The Surveyor reported to the Board that Wessler is working with INDOT and has made a little bit of progress.

COUNTY FARM DRAIN

Rees showed photos of the washed-out drainage tile and suggested a waterway needs to be added. He stated he would contact NRCS to get information about possible financial aid.

SAM TRABUE TILE

Landowner Doug Hall addressed the Board about repairs on the Sam Trabue Tile and was told by Rees the project is on the list to be repaired.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Levi made a motion to adjourn with a 2nd by Wilkinson. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
