

Options for Completion of Required Divorcing Parents Program

Course Title: Divorcing Parents

Divorce is very painful experience for everyone involved. However, children can develop problems during this time that can follow them into their adult years. Studies suggest that the conflict between parents causes more pain and stress for children than the divorce itself. The goal of this seminar is to teach parents how to lessen the pain, reduce the conflict and understand the effects of divorce on children. The class meets the court ordered requirements for divorcing parents. We are offering individual sessions so you can call and schedule a time that works best for you.

Location:

The seminar is held at Harcourt Counseling Services, 117 East Third Street, Rushville. From Main Street turn east on Third Street. We are on the right side of the street, in a brick building with a black awning.

Cost:

The cost is \$70 per person and must be paid in cash before class begins. Call 765-932-5905 to register. Children are NOT to attend. This course is for the parent(s) ONLY.

Course Title: Children In Between

Participants will receive a certificate after completing the 4-hour in-person program or online course.

Cost (for either program format):

\$50 per person
