

**SPECIAL SESSION RUSH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS JUNE 12, 2020**

The Rush County Board of Commissioners met in special session Friday, June 12, 2020 with Commissioners Mark Bacon, Paul Wilkinson and Bruce Levi in attendance. Auditor Jodi Harr and County Attorney Leigh Morning were also in attendance.

The meeting was properly advertised. The only topic on the agenda is COVID-19 and opening the courthouse to the public.

Commissioner Mark Bacon called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

**COVID-19**

The courthouse will remain having only one open entrance to enter the building. The commissioners requested an email go out to employees reminding them of this.

Paul Wilkinson made the motion to approve the quote from Washmoth Cabinets in the amount of \$13,300.00 to install the crash doors on the North, East and South doors of the courthouse. This will enable the county security officer to ask the COVID-19 health questions, take temperatures and log who is entering and exiting the courthouse. Bruce Levi seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Bruce Levi made the motion to open the courthouse to the public beginning Monday, June 22, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. The additional time is needed for construction and safety measures to be made. All offices will remain open to the public until then by prearranged appointment only. Paul Wilkinson seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

County Attorney Leigh Morning presented the new amended guidelines for opening Rush County Courthouse for Coronavirus/COVID-19. Paul Wilkinson made the motion to approve the amended guidelines. Bruce Levi seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Bruce Levi made the motion to adjourn. Paul Wilkinson seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.
