GLENWOOD HEARING

Geoff Wessling , Attorney for the Town of Glenwood, advised the Board everyone in Glenwood is in favor of creating a new drain. The Surveyor reported that he had not received any remonstrance or objections. Bacon asked the Glenwood residents if they had any objections – there were no objections. Wilkinson made a motion with a 2nd by Bacon to refer the petition to Rees for his final report. Motion carried. The Surveyor asked Leigh Morning if the Railroad representatives were required to witness the signing of the permits. Morning stated they were not and that Rees could witness the signing. Wilkinson made a motion with a 2nd by Bacon to sign the permits. Chairman Bacon signed the permits.

WM. GARNER OPEN

The Surveyor reminded the Board of the Garner Open Hearing at the next meeting and advised we may have a full house.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Wilkinson made a motion with a 2nd by Bacon to adjourn. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
