

SPECIAL SESSION RUSH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SEPTEMBER 21, 2020

The Rush County Board of Commissioners met in special session Monday, September 21, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. with Commissioners Mark Bacon and Paul Wilkinson. Bruce Levi was absent. Jodi Harr, Auditor, and County Attorney Leigh Morning were also in attendance.

Mark Bacon called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss and approve a contract between Rush Memorial Hospital and Rush County Health Department to provide COVID-19 testing.

Rush County has been approved for a grant from the Indiana State Department of Health CFDA #21.019 and 93.323 CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Fund and Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity grant in the amount of \$100,000.00. It is to be used for COVID 19 testing to the public. Rush Memorial has the facility and staff to provide the testing. Paul Wilkinson made the motion to approve the contract with Rush Memorial Hospital. Mark Bacon seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Paul Wilkinson made the motion that Rush Memorial Hospital will not start the testing until the grant funds are received by Rush County. Mark Bacon seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Paul Wilkinson made the motion to adjourn. Mark Bacon seconded. Motion carried.
