

ORDINANCE 2022- 4

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY
MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2022, the Indiana Department of Transportation closed State Road 44 west of the City of Rushville for emergency culvert repair; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of all citizens of and travelers through Rush County, Indiana, to establish a temporary maximum speed limit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Rush County, Indiana:

1. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to Ind.Code 36-1-3-2, I.C. 9-21-5-3, and I.C. 9-21-5-4.

2. A temporary maximum speed limit of 30 miles per hour is established along the following roads:

a. County Road 125 West in a northerly direction between State Road 44 and Old State Road 44; Old State Road 44 in an easterly and westerly direction between County Road 125 West and 275 West; County Road 275 West in a northerly and southerly direction between Old State Road 44 and State Road 44.

b. Flatrock River Road in a southerly direction between State Road 44 and County Road 150 South; County Road 150 South in an easterly and westerly direction between Flatrock River Road and County Road 200 West; County Road 200 West in a northerly and southerly direction between 150 South and County Road 200 South; County Road 200 South in an easterly and westerly direction between County Road 200 West and 275 West; County Road 275 West in a northerly and southerly direction between County Road 200 South and State Road 44.


3. Any violation of this Ordinance is a Class C infraction pursuant to I.C. 9-21-5-4(b).


4. An emergency exists for this Ordinance, due to the emergency closing of State Road 44 by the Indiana Department of Transportation.

5. This Ordinance is effective as of March 28, 2022, after the posting of signs along all affected roads, and continues in effect until its repeal. This Ordinance shall be advertised.


