

DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING

RE-ORGANIZE THE BOARD

Jarman made motion for Mark Bacon to be President of the Board, 2nd by Aulbach. Motion carried.

Jarman made motion for Kenny Aulbach to be Vice President of the Board, 2nd by Bacon. Motion carried.

RUSHVILLE FLOODING

Chuck stated that a letter from the Commissioners and the City are needed for the grant. This was discussed at the Commissioners meeting and will be taken care of. The letter needs to be sent out no later than the 10th of January.

CLYDE DEPUTY DRAIN

Surveyor presented maps of drain and the area that needs attention. 2005 was the last time it was worked on. Aulbach asked about the needed repairs and the map showing two possible solutions and questioned if it was feasible to move the tile. Surveyor stated that it needs to be put on the Long Range Plan for partial reconstruction and this will be addresses at that time.

STEWART PETITION HEARING

Surveyor reminded the Board of the hearing on January 10th, 2023 at 1:00 p.m.

COUNTY FARM TILE

Joe Niedenthal came before the Board and stated there are roots in the tile. He stated the work of the trees being removed was good but it needs to be kept mowed. Surveyor stated he would check with Rusty to discover the size on the tile at the property line. Niedenthal would like to see a new tile installed thru the county property or an open drain thru the property. Surveyor stated an open drain turning into a tile would not work. Once the size of the tile is known. Surveyor will put together an estimate to replace the tile.
