## SR 44 PRIVATE TILE ISSUE

The tile ran between two trees planted on the approximately property line between Schroeder and County property. Roots got in the tiles as well as pieces of the old tile from repairs of long ago and the tile pieces got caught on the roots causing the blockage. The two trees were removed and non-perforated tile was installed. A breather was also installed. This should help with the water issue if not fix it.

## **BLOUNT FLETCHER TILE**

Surveyor stated that this tile was reconstructed in 2012. Surveyor presented pictures of the hole that was created when the tile was apparently laid in "sugar sand". The sand got washed out and caused the tile to sink. Large rip-rap was installed under the tile and non-perforated tile was re-installed.

With nothing else to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned on motion by Jarman, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Aulbach. Motion carried.
