

**DRAINAGE BOARD MEETING**

**September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

The Rush County Drainage Board met at 10:36a.m. September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025 with the following present; Kenny Aulbach, Jeff Wilson, Ron Jarman, Marvin L. Rees, Surveyor, Jeremy Wood, Apprentice Surveyor, Ashley Perkins, Secretary. Also present Doug Hall, James Ramsey, and Cindy Humphrey. Grant Reeves and Tom Mahan was not present.

The minutes of the meeting that was held on August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025 were approved and signed by Wilson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Aulbach. Motion carried.

**FRALEY/WILKER**

Cindy Humphrey presented to the Board about the concern of her area and flooding. She stated after it brought to her attention about Coons fixing Baker Street that it will cause an issue for her. She stated that it is okay if they don't get over 2 inch of rain. Cindy stated about putting rock on the side. Jarman asked how she make it a regulated drain. Surveyor stated someone would have to petition for it. Surveyor stated he would like him and Kenny to get with DNR and see what can be done. Surveyor he will contact DNR and let them know. Surveyor also asked the Board about the assessment on paying back in one year or two years. The Board suggested two years for pay off.

**WEBB/WILLIS/MULL**

Surveyor stated that Dierckman's project should be a reconstruction drain. Dierckman stated to the Board that if we make it a reconstruction drain the county would be reliable for the pipe. Board made motion do as maintenance connect 36' piping into the headwall on the eastside of Flatrock River and hook onto the westside at their expense and that as soon as it is installed Dierckman is to reconvert it back to the county, Dierckman agreed with the Board by Wilson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hall. Ron Jarman opposed to the motion, motion carried.

**JOHN GAHIMER TILE**

Surveyor presented maps. James Ramsey presented to the Board that he spoke to the landowners and they are all on board with the project. Surveyor stated he will get with Jerry to go out there to look at the outlet. Aulbach stated he wants an outside consultant to look as well. Surveyor stated to get with him as well.

**CARR/STANLEY OUTLET**

James Ramsey stated to the Board they started this past Friday September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025 on the project. They got the 22 degree fitting put in. Waiting on the big machines to get there and will start placing rock. Hopefully everything going in the next two weeks.

**DRAINAGE SCHOOL**

Surveyor stated Breanna mentioned in the online drainage school meeting that if a tile runs through a bunch of landowners the are responsible for fixing the tile and if the landowner doesn't fix the tile the other landowner has the right to fix it.

Reminder, Trabue bids are next meeting.

With nothing else to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned by Wilson. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jarman. Motion carried.
