

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-6

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CHANGE IN THE SPEED LIMIT FOR
CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS IN RUSH COUNTY, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Rush County, Indiana, has determined that, in the interest of public safety and in accordance with Indiana Code § 9-21-5-6, it is necessary and reasonable to establish a speed limit on certain county roads in and around Arlington, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, an engineering and traffic investigation is not required as the area in question qualifies as an urban district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Rush County, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. Designation of Speed Limit

The maximum lawful speed on the following county-road segments located in the unincorporated town of Arlington shall be Thirty (30) Miles Per Hour (MPH):

1. On County Road 150 N, beginning at its intersection with County Road 725 W and extending easterly to County Road 700 W; and
2. On County Road 700 W, beginning at its intersection with State Road 52 and extending south to its intersection with County Road 150 N.

Section 2. Violation

A person who violates this speed regulation commits a Class C infraction under Indiana law.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval, and proper posting of regulatory signs in accordance with Indiana Code § 9-21-5-6.

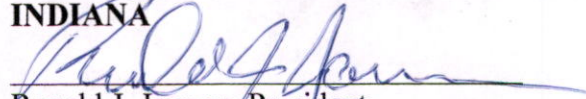
Section 4. Severability

If any provision of this Ordinance is found to conflict with state or federal law, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

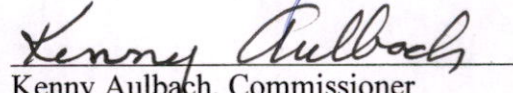

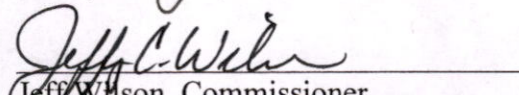

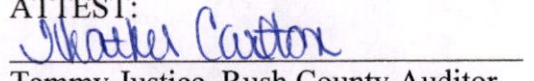
