ORDINANCE NO. 2025-6

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CHANGE IN THE SPEED LIMIT FOR CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS IN RUSH COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Rush County, Indiana, has determined that, in the interest of public safety and in accordance with Indiana Code § 9-21-5-6, it is necessary and reasonable to establish a speed limit on certain county roads in and around Arlington, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, an engineering and traffic investigation is not required as the area in question qualifies as an urban district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Rush County, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. Designation of Speed Limit

The maximum lawful speed on the following county-road segments located in the unincorporated town of Arlington shall be Thirty (30) Miles Per Hour (MPH):

- 1. On County Road 150 N, beginning at its intersection with County Road 725 W and extending easterly to County Road 700 W; and
- 2. On County Road 700 W, beginning at its intersection with State Road 52 and extending south to its intersection with County Road 150 N.

Section 2. Violation

A person who violates this speed regulation commits a Class C infraction under Indiana law.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval, and proper posting of regulatory signs in accordance with Indiana Code § 9-21-5-6.

Section 4. Severability

If any provision of this Ordinance is found to conflict with state or federal law, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
