

SPECIAL SESSION RUSH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS February 13, 2026

The Rush County Board of Commissioners met in a special session on Friday, February 13, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. with Commissioners Ron Jarman, Jeff Wilson and Kenny Aulbach present. Also in attendance was Auditor Tammy Justice. County Attorney Grant Reeves was not present.

Commissioner Ron Jarman called the special session to order with the Pledge to the American Flag.

The purpose of the special session was to discuss moratoriums on data centers in the county. The meeting was properly advertised.

DATA CENTERS

- Area Plan Director updated the Commissioners and the public on the status of the UDO that is currently being amended.
- Discussion was held and Jeff Wilson clarified that the UDO is not changing what policies the county currently has, it is taking current policies and putting them into a better system. The UDO will add nuclear and data centers. Jeff Wilson moved to put a 90-day moratorium on all data centers in Rush County. Second, by Ron Jarman. Kenny Aulbach was not in favor. Motion carried.

Kenny Aulbach moved to adjourn. Second, by Jeff Wilson. All were in favor. Motion carried.
