PUBLIC TEST OF VOTING MACHINES

Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Rush County Election Board announce there will be a public test of the Microvote Infinity voting machines held on Wednesday, March 25th, at 2:00 p.m. on the first floor of the courthouse.

The test will be conducted by the members of the Rush County Election Board. Members of the public *cannot participate* in the testing, however, they are welcome to attend and observe the process.

Testing of three to four voting machines is done in accordance with I.C. 3-11-13-22 to ensure that each vote cast is recorded correctly. There will also be sample absentee ballot cards tabulated on the optical scan device to make sure that each vote on a paper absentee ballot is recorded correctly.

Once the test is concluded, the board members certify the test results with the Indiana Election Division.
